

## **BYLAWS OF EXMOUTH ROWING CLUB**

1. The colours of the club shall be red and white. Racing kit to be of a type determined by the management committee.
2. No crew or sculler shall compete under the name of the club without the sanction of the CAPTAIN.
3. No boat or equipment belonging to the club shall be used unless authorised by either the CAPTAIN or BOAT CAPTAIN.
4. The COX or STROKE (as applicable) of any crew shall be in charge of the boat and be responsible for its safety. The crew must be clearly briefed in this respect before leaving the boathouse. Thereafter all orders given by the person responsible shall be obeyed without question.
5. Any mishap to boat or equipment must be reported to the CAPTAIN &/or BOAT CAPTAIN and entered in the boathouse log. Individual members may be held liable for wilful damage or damage known to have been caused by their negligence.
6. Each crew or sculler is responsible for the correct stowage of boat and equipment in the boathouse after use, either for training or after any event.
7. The last crew or sculler off the water at each session is responsible for ensuring the security and locking up of the boathouse.
8. Any tools received from the boathouse must be returned immediately after use to the boathouse.
9. Every member is responsible for ensuring the boathouse; boats and equipment are kept clean and tidy.
10. All membership fees are due in full on 1st April. Any person not paying his/her subscription within 4 weeks in any club year will cease to be a member of the club and as such will no longer be entitled to row or use club equipment.

11. Membership is available in the following categories:

- LIFE MEMBER, Elected at AGM only, no membership fee;
- FULL (ROWING);
- JUNIOR;
- STUDENT, a member in full time, unpaid education;
- VICE-PRESIDENT. Vice Presidents are normally full members of another club and pay half of the clubs full rowing membership.

12. Membership fees shall be paid in full upon application. The use of club facilities by potential applicants shall be at the discretion of the CAPTAIN.

13. All members whilst afloat shall be of uniform attire, to be determined in advance according to prevailing weather conditions.

14. All boats, in accordance with 'rule of the road' shall keep to the starboard side of any fairway. Priority shall be given to other rowing craft proceeding down stream.

15. Privately owned boats racked in the club boathouse may be charged a fee for racking, such fee to be set by the management committee; all insurance cover to be the responsibility of the owner. Owners of such boats shall comply with rules as set by management committee from time to time.
